The journey to Heriot-Watt University by bus takes approximately 30 minutes from the city centre. Lothian Buses offers services 25, 25X, 34, 45 and N25 to Heriot-Watt University.

The 25 departs from Princes Street, via Haymarket, Gorgie Road and Sighthill. The 25X has a limited stop route beginning at Waterloo Place via Princes Street, Lothian Road and running non-stop to Sighthill before arriving at Heriot-Watt University. The 34 departs from Princes Street via Lothian Road, Fountainbridge, Slateford Road and Sighthill.

The 25 is the most frequent bus to the Edinburgh Campus, leaving the city centre every 15 minutes during the day, and every 30 minutes after 20.30. During peak times in the morning and evening, Monday to Friday, the 25X runs to the Edinburgh Campus every 15-20 minutes.

The 45 leaves from St Andrew Square via The Mound, Tollcross, Bruntsfield, Merchiston and Craiglockhart. This service operates every 30 minutes, Monday to Friday, from 06.30 to 18.30.

The 25 runs until midnight, after which time Lothian Buses operate the N25, an hourly night bus to the Edinburgh Campus from Waverley train station via Princes Street, Haymarket, Balgreen and Sighthill.

West Lothian Council run the No 555 between the Hermiston Park and Ride and Edinburgh International Airport. The service runs every 2 hours throughout the day, for further details please contact the West Lothian Travel Helpline – 01506 775288. The Hermiston Park and Ride is approx 10 minute walk from the Edinburgh Campus, it can also be accessed by taking the LRT No.25 service referred to above.

TELEPHONE

All rooms have a telephone that guests can use to receive calls and make room-to-room calls at no charge. Incoming calls can be made by dialling 0044(0)870 050 0153. The automated attendant will play the Heriot-Watt greeting and ask your caller to key in your room extension number. You'll find your extension number written on your phone handset.

To make calls to any other destinations you will need a Heriot-Watt Guest Calling Card which offers very competitive rates to all UK and international destinations. Cards cost £5 and are available from Reception. You can also use the card from any UK phone so you can make calls even after you have left us.

A full list of call rates is available at Reception, however UK national calls start at 3.5 pence per minute (ppm) and European countries such as France, Germany, Italy, Spain all at less than 5 ppm.
